Police Authority Appoints Assistant Chief Constable

Humberside Police Authority has announced the appointment of Stuart Donald as Assistant Chief Constable (Operations), Humberside Police with immediate effect.

Mr Donald, who is 44, grew up in Scunthorpe and joined Humberside Police in 1985 as a Police Constable. Having risen steadily through the ranks and spent time on every Division in the Force, in 2006 he was appointed Divisional Commander for the North Lincolnshire Division.

Following the announcement he said: "Having joined Humberside Police as a Constable, I am delighted to be chosen to join the Chief Officer team of a Force that I have been proud to serve for 23 years. I have enjoyed a great working relationship with colleagues, partners and the communities of the Humberside Police area and will continue to do my very best to make our communities safer."

Vice Chair of the Police Authority, Cllr David Rudd, said that the appointment followed a rigorous selection process. He added: "On behalf of the Police Authority I am pleased to welcome Stuart to the senior officer team of Humberside Police. His vast experience and knowledge of policing in Humberside will undoubtedly complement the command team and I feel sure that we have made the right choice.

Background

Stuart Donald has strong links with the people of the Humberside Police area, having grown up in Scunthorpe and joined Humberside Police in 1985. He spent the early years of his service working as a detective in Hull and specialist in the Force Drug Squad. He has been commended four times.

During his career he has gained a degree in Social Science and a Masters degree in Criminology from the University of Hull.

He was promoted to Superintendent in 1999 and has held operational command roles in each of the four police divisions of Humberside Police. He has also commanded the Traffic and Training Units. After working regionally to improve protective services collaborative arrangements, in 2006 he was appointed Divisional Commander with responsibility for the Unitary Authority area of North Lincolnshire.

He recently graduated from the prestigious Strategic Command Course at Bramshill.
