### Home Secretary to Attend Anti-Social Behaviour Conference in Hessle

Home Secretary Alan Johnson will address an anti social behaviour conference in Hessle tomorrow (26<sup>th</sup> March 2010) and hear how police are improving protection for vulnerable people.

Representatives from a wide range of local organisations engaged in tackling anti-social behaviour will be at the conference organised by HumberSide Police Authority and HumberSide Police.

Leicestershire Police will discuss lessons learned from the tragic death of Fiona Pilkington and her daughter Francesca and HumberSide Police will launch its new ASB Strategy which highlights how the Force will respond to vulnerable victims who may be repeatedly attacked.

Representatives from Greater Manchester Police and Victim Support are also attending.

Chair of the HumberSide Police Authority, Alene Branton, MBE, said:

“The Force and its partners have worked hard to achieve significant falls in the level of anti social behaviour across our area.

“However, in our recent Citizen Panel survey local people told us anti social behaviour remains one of their top concerns. So, along with the Chief Constable, we decided to bring together a broad range of experience to see how we can improve the quality of lives of local people.”
