New Leadership for Police Authority

Members of HumberSide Police Authority will elect a new chairperson at the Annual General Meeting to be held on Tuesday 29th June 2010.

Cllr Christopher Matthews is the only member to have submitted a statement in support of his intent to stand for election as chair.

This will be followed by the election of the Vice-Chair of the Authority.

Members will also consider a variety of reports including an overview of Force Performance; the potential for regional working and an update on the improvements made to CRB checks.

The meeting will commence at approximately 11.00am, following the conclusion of the Authority's Finance Committee meeting. It will be held at Pacific Exchange, 40 High Street, Hull, and members of the public are welcome to attend to observe elections and debates.

HumberSide Police Authority is made up of 17 members; eight independent members and nine councillors nominated by local authorities. Police Authorities are independent bodies that hold the Police Force to account on behalf of local communities.

Local Police Authorities along with the Home Secretary and Chief Officers of Police make up the tripartite relationship which is responsible for the governance of policing in England and Wales.
