Derringham and Boothferry Sports Projects	Hull	£500	Project to provide young people aged 11 – 19 with a 12 week sports and activity period during the summer months and the schools holidays.
Hornsea Heroes - Girls	Hornsea	£500	Provide equipment and kit for the establishment of a girls soccer club in Hornsea following the success of the establishment of a boys club by the same project.
Flames Roller Hockey Club	Driffield	£500	Money used to purchase kit and equipment for the Flames Roller Hockey project so that they can expand and become involved in regional and national competition.
Children and Family Action	Withernsea	£500	Setting up a junior warden scheme in the town, buying protective and high vis clothing for the young people who will participate in litter picking and general warden activities during the summer months.
Pentecostal Youth Crew	Hornsea	£500	Purchase more sports/activity equipment for expanding youth crew based at local church.
Concert for Youth Group	Hornsea	£500	Purchase a professional stage and sound system for young people to develop their musical and performing skills
Bridlington Club for Young People	Bridlington	£500	Purchase new sports equipment for youth club which has recently expanded its member base
Swanland Playing Field Association	Swnaland	£500	Money to be used on the erection of youth shelter and associated facilities, such as rubbish bins, to be used by local young people
Holme-on-Spalding Moor Parish Plan Advisory Committee	Holme-on-Spalding Moor	£500	Money funded local research by the Parish Council to canvas every young person in the Parish so that they could identify their own recreational needs so that provisions could be included in the Parish plan

Northern Pocket Bike Club	Hull	£500	Project to organise a safe, supervised location where young people can ride their mini-motos with safety clothing and considerations being supplied by the local neighbourhood police and partners.
St Paul's Amateur Boxing Club	Hull	£500	New punch bags and head guards to be purchased for the new youngsters who have joined the club
Quantock Youth Group	Grimsby	£500	Provide equipment and training staff for a programme of sports coaching sessions for teenagers
Hull and District Youth Rugby League	Hull	£500	Purchase small sized rugby balls for the expanding youth section of the club.
Youth in the Community	Hessle	£500	Project to develop peer mentors from Hessle High School in the 14 – 15 yrs age range with involvement in a pre public service course and increased profile within the local community. Money spent on protective clothing, training and equipment
Crosby and District Out Of School Club	Scunthorpe	£500	Funding paid for a day trip for the young people who use the service – many of whom had never been out of Scunthorpe before.
West Marsh Community Centre	Grimsby	£500	Half term activities programme including football, dancing, karate, cycling, motor project and arts and crafts. Based in the West Marsh Community Centre for young people
Thorpes Community Centre	Hull	£500	Equipment and sports activities for young people in expanding young person club on council housing estate
Anlaby Youth Initiatives	Anlaby	£500	Building works and furnishings for a new youth centre for and existing group.
HYPaCT	Hornsea	£500	Hornsea Young People and Community Together group to produce regular newsletters and community magazine with directory for young peoples interests and projects for young people.
